TOLI's Mississippi seminar, **Reclaiming Our Humanity**, asks educators to consider these questions: What makes us human? What happens when our humanity is threatened? In this writing and inquiry-based seminar, participants examine anti-Jewish laws and Jim Crow laws, make connections to human rights issues of today, and consider how to bring these difficult topics into the classroom using a pedagogy of hope. The seminar will invite participants to consider how music, art, and poetry are powerful tools of resistance. Connecting to the past can help our students gain insight about the present and consider how they might create an equitable future.
